1. Who is responsible for any SCDOT encroachment permits?

The City currently maintains SCDOT encroachment permits for the existing signs, where required. The City will be responsible for maintaining these permits and/or applying for any additional permits if required by SCDOT.

2. Will any City permits be required for this project (i.e. sign permit, zoning permit, other city permit, county permits, etc.)?

A sign permit is not required for this project. The selected vendor will be responsible for obtaining a City of Clemson business license.

3. Please confirm the existing signs will be removed by the city prior to installation of the new signs.

The existing signs will be removed by the City prior to installation of new signs. The selected vendor will work with City Staff to coordinate scheduling.

4. Please confirm the city will remove any landscaping to be protected prior to the new sign installation.

The City will be responsible for all landscaping aspects of this project. The selected vendor will work with City Staff to coordinate scheduling.

5. Please confirm the city will be responsible for all landscaping around the sign after new sign installation.

The City will be responsible for all landscaping aspects of this project. The selected vendor will work with City Staff to coordinate scheduling.

6. Please confirm the new signs are non-illuminated and no electrical work will be required.

The selected vendor will be responsible for maintaining the integrity of the existing electrical on site. The City will be responsible for illuminating the signs post construction.

7. Will the city provide traffic control?

The City will be responsible for any traffic control that might be necessary for the completion of this project.

8. Will working hours be restricted at any time?

Construction noise is allowed Monday through Friday 7:00AM - 8:00PM and Sunday 12:00PM - 8:00PM.

9. Is there a project schedule/completion deadline?

We plan to move forward with the project in early Spring. The City will coordinate with the selected vendor on the scheduling of the demo of the existing signs. We would like for the signs to be completed no later than June 30, 2024.

10. Will progress billing be allowed?

Yes. Draw downs will be allowed based on completed work.

11. Are there any special warranties/guarantees?

Work should be warranted for one year post installation.

12. Is sales tax to be included in the cost proposal?

Yes.

13. Is there a budget for this project?

\$75,000.

14. Please confirm if we are providing the brick work and stone veneers as well? If yes provide all relevant details applicable

The selected vendor will be responsible for the fabrication and installation of the signs. This includes the stone veneer columns as depicted in the solicitation. The vendor shall provide recommendations for stone colors based on sign design.

15. Are the signs double sided?

Sign 1: 12" deep wall with the back left as CMU block

Sign 2: 12" deep wall with the back left as CMU block

Sign 3: 12" deep wall with the back to be finished with stone

Sign 4: 12" deep wall with the back to be finished with stone

16. Mounting method of Sign panel

Stud mounted to 2" aluminum cabinet secured to stone monument.

17. What is the raised letter material? What lettering is 1/2"? What lettering is painted?

The cabinet shall be masked and painted dark blue, orange, light blue and white. The City logo shall be 1/2" acrylic painted. "Clemson" "Pickens County" and Pickens County tag line "Adventure Starts Here" shall be 1/2" acrylic painted.

18. What is the size of the lettering?

The City will provide the EPS files of the designs to the selected vendor. The vendor will be responsible for scaling the design.

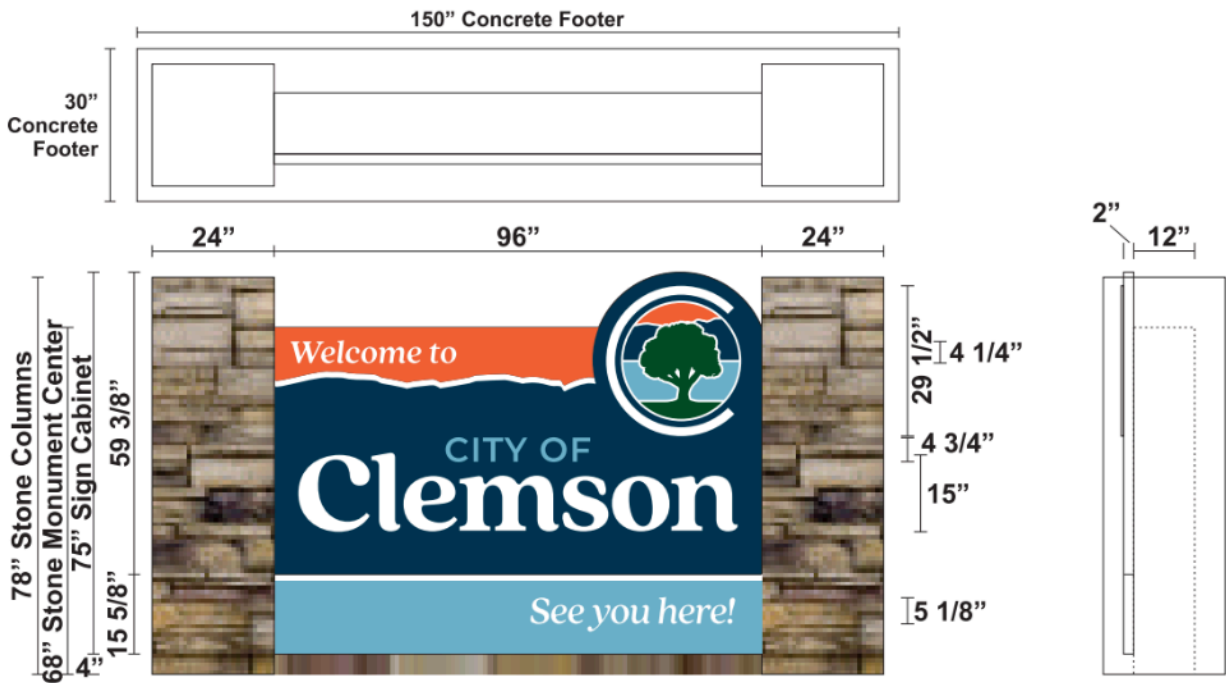
19. Does the height 120" include the logo circle?
