Working Recommendations:

Enhance the Small Business Ecosystem

- 1. New: Require developers of new mixed-use buildings to put up a bond equal to \$50 per square foot of commercial space to be released when those funds are spent/needed for an actual build-out of that space.
- 2. New: Prior to issuing a building permit, the developer will have a City staff-approved marketing plan for the commercial space. (*The developer shall be required to provide staff with a monthly activity report outlining their marketing efforts to fill the commercial space. This will commence with the issuance of a CO and continue until the space is filled.*)
- 3. Edited: Incentivize property owners to fill vacant commercial space by establishing a vacant storefront registration requirement and fee that includes a means to identify vacant spaces from the street and through a database or spreadsheet maintained by City staff.

(Work group agreed with this possible language pending review by City attorney: Any new or existing vacant properties must register with the City after 90-days of being vacant. The registration must be accompanied by a Vacant Property Registration fee of \$50.

Registration requires signing a contract that states the owner:

- Understands the IPMC (What is the IPMC?)
- Provides a local contact for maintenance
- Provides a listing agent and contact information
- Agrees to have this info added to a spreadsheet of available properties and square footage so it can be shared with developers/potential tenants.

Any ground floor commercial space facing or adjacent to (within 50'of) a sidewalk, property owners have to cover the windows with an applique if the property is vacant for more than 90 days.

- New construction with vacant commercial will not be issued a CO until appliques are in place.
- The applique cannot include more than 32 square feet advertising the space as being available for sale or lease.
- Each applique must be approved by the Arts and Culture Commission.
- The applique needs to be changed every 90-days.)
- 4. Establish a Business Improvement District (BID) to support Downtown business retention, marketing, and recruitment efforts.

New: Create an Entrepreneurial Support System within the City

- 1. Establish a community-based incubator or other entity to strengthen innovation and entrepreneurship. Invite local Universities to partner with the city to ensure opportunities are created for University staff and students to participate.
- 2. Hire a Business Development Director whose responsibilities would include:
 - Attending all relevant Business and Economic committee meetings and acting as the liaison between all active City and Clemson University economic committees
 - Maintaining and ensuring compliance with the vacant storefront registration program
 - Creating, providing, and maintaining information on how to start a business in Clemson including all relevant contact information and applications
 - Provide small business/entrepreneur workshops or networking events on a monthly basis
 - Create and maintain a directory of local businesses
 - Establishing a community-based incubator (potentially with the support of one or more local Universities/Colleges)
 - Being the one point of contact between local businesses and university departments/faculty/students to match potential business needs with university opportunities for internships/projects and vice versa
 - Running the BID and BID programs?
