| What percentage of commercial properties in the City are vacant? | Ongoing |
| As of February 21, 2022 the percentage of commercial properties vacant in the City is 6.4%. This is substantially lower than the national average which was last reported on April 20, 2022 as 15.9% | |
| What is the process for code enforcement in the City? (Specifically derelict homes and high grass) | Procedure in Place |
| When we identify an issue or one is brought to our attention the first step is to contact the owner and make them aware of the problem and ask them to correct it. We give the owner 7-10 days to respond with either the issue being corrected or a plan put in place for correcting the issue, depending on the extent of the problem/violation. If they do not respond we send a formal letter with a firm deadline. If they then fail to address the matter we issue a ticket and settle the matter in Court. You may report an issue/concern using the MyCivic app. When you open the app, select 'Report an Issue' then select 'Planning and Codes'. | |
| Can the Clemson Municipal Court offer community service as a diversionary option? | Procedure in Place |
| No. Diversion Programs are administered through the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit Solicitor's Office. One example of this is the Alcohol Education Program (AEP), a diversion program for first time offenders with alcohol related offenses. This program allows the defendant to participate in counseling and community service in order to get their charge dismissed. | |
