Action Item	Status
Increase pedestrian safety on Addison Lane <i>The police will conduct a traffic study to determine when the violations are occurring so they can use the data to determine when enforcement is needed most. The Public Works Department will replace any missing signs and make sure we have speed limit signs at the College Ave side of Addison, the middle portion, and the Hwy 93 outlet. Speed bumps may also be considered in the overall plan.</i>	Ongoing
Public Behavior in the Addison/Hillcrest are <i>Nuisance behavior has been occurring in this area. Primarily on game days. Please call 911 or 624-2000 to report any nuisance or criminal behavior as soon as you observe it taking place.</i>	Ongoing
Safety issues related scooters, skateboards, bikes and golf carts on public streets <i>These modes of transportation often share the same space pedestrians use. Staff will look at locations to post regulations for pedestrian use paths.</i>	In Progress
City vehicles traveling at a high rate of speed on Cochran Road. <i>The Utilities Director has been made aware of this and will address the problem.</i>	Complete
Can speeding tickets be issued for violations caught on camera? <i>Not in South Carolina. The Officer must observe the violation and physically hand them a ticket.</i>	Complete
Can a public restroom be installed downtown? <i>The City will need to re-purpose or renovate the police sub-station on College Avenue in the very near future. Including a public restroom is an option.</i>	Ongoing
What can the public do to assist the police? <i>Call the police for any concern. Do not hesitate to call when you observe something taking place. Please call 911 or 624-2000 if something seems amiss or suspicious. Please also lock your car and house doors.</i>	Complete
Sometimes it is difficult to determine which City Department is the most appropriate to call because we don't know who enforces what. <i>Citizens can always call the police if they are not sure who to call. The Police will direct the call to the appropriate on call employee.</i>	Complete
