Action Item	Status
Would like the speed limit in Dellwood to be 15mph <i>Police will reach out to the person who made this request to learn more about the underlying issues to determine the best way to address the problem.</i>	In Progress
Speed limit signs on Addison and Hillcrest seem to be getting stolen. <i>Public Works enhanced this area by painting one way arrows/do not enter signs on the pavement at each intersection. Two more tamper proof speed limit signs will be installed.</i>	Complete
Rental Housing: Can we go to 4 years off and 1 year on for those with good track record? <i>This is not recommended at this time. The City suspended rental housing inspections at the onset of the pandemic to reduce exposure to citizens and employees. Staff saw this as an opportunity to determine if annual inspections were needed moving forward. Staff resumed inspections this year and found a marked increase in the number of properties that had fallen out of compliance.</i>	Complete
Ensure that dogs using the dog park are registered and have their shots. <i>Staff is researching similar policies and will be discussing this request with the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee. Staff is also evaluating our animal laws to determine if updates are needed.</i>	In Progress
At the Grange, will it be possible to direct all traffic toward road 18 instead of Chapman Hill Road? <i>Staff is looking into this.</i>	In Progress
Add park benches to Green Crescent Trail bridge. <i>Staff is looking at locations that would be appropriate for a resting area at the GCT Bridge.</i>	In Progress
Address speeding on Issaqueena between Camelot and Berkeley. <i>Police will conduct a speed study and use the data to develop an enforcement plan.</i>	Ongoing
